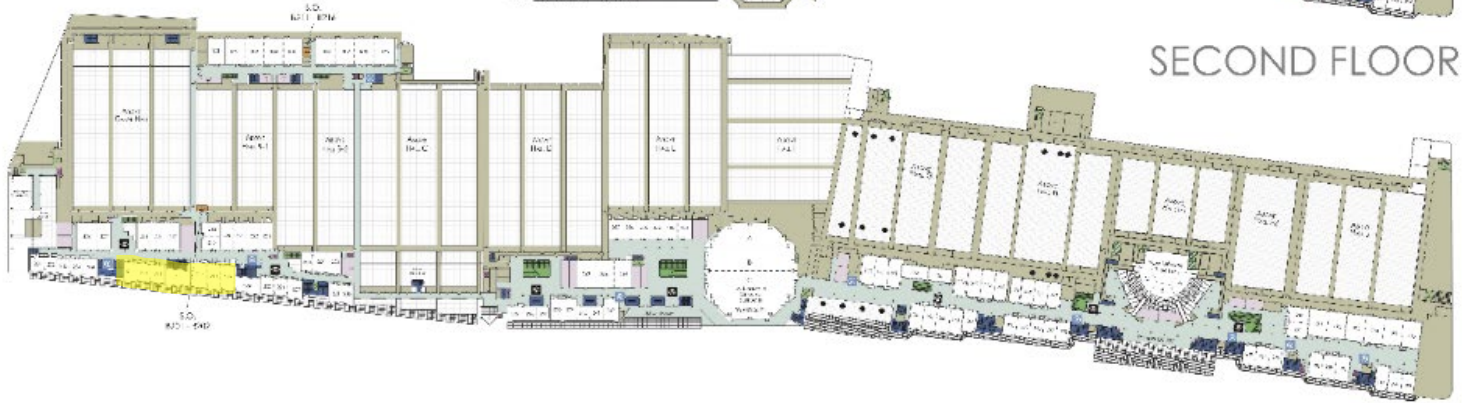

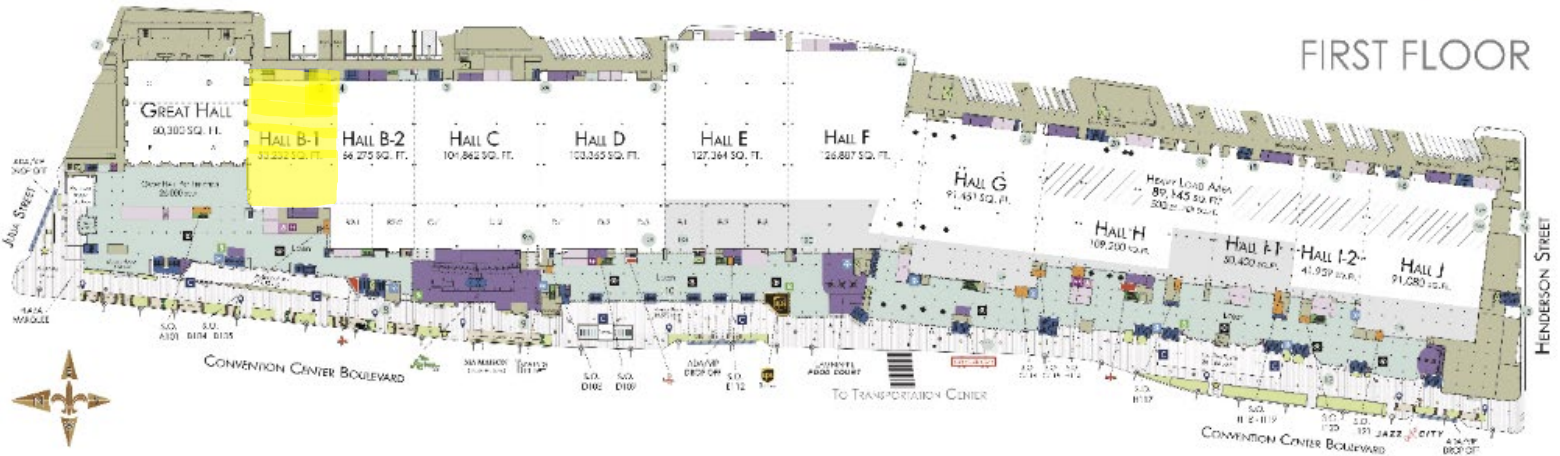

Sustainability

Ongoing sustainability efforts of the Convention Center team concentrates on four major components of sustainability: Energy Conservation, Water Conservation, Clean Air Practices, and Waste Reduction. We're also undergoing the pursuit of the top sustainability certification. Our recent initiatives in this area include:

- ✦ Energy Conservation – We employ LED lighting technologies and advanced control sensors to achieve the most efficient lighting and HVAC possible as well as upgrading our HVAC. Our lighting and HVAC projects have reduced our energy use by 10-15%.
- ✦ Water Conservation – The Convention Center has water efficient low-flow faucets in our restrooms. Our park showcases stormwater management and rain gardens that aid in the diversion of rain water. We've also incorporated bottle filling stations throughout the Convention Center.
- ✦ Clean Air Practices – Our operations team monitors equipment for efficiency and employs the use of environmentally preferable cleaners when possible.
- ✦ Waste Reduction – Recycling is provided for plastic, paper, aluminum and cardboard for attendees in both the lobbies and exhibit halls with additional measures available upon request. Our food and beverage partner provides compostable serving products as much as possible and has active composting and food donation programs. We also can provide attendee composting upon request.
- ✦ Certification - The New Orleans Ernest N. Morial Convention Center has embarked on the process of pursuing the prestigious LEED certification for an existing facility. Once complete NOENMCC will be the largest existing Convention Center with this green building designation.
